## Northwest Pacific Coast: Haida Lino Block Printmaking

**Your task:** You will create a series of prints that feature your chosen animal incorporating the Haida style features.

## Procedure:

- 1. Select a visual reference (picture of an animal).
- 2. Trace the linoleum block in your sketchbook a few times.
- 3. Draw your animal in the Haida style. Keep your lines and shapes spaced out!
- 4. Once a design has been approved, you will transfer it onto the linoleum very carefully.
- 5. Carve your design using the subtractive method demonstrated in class.
- 6. Create a series of prints that incorporates the following:
  - a. Solid colour
  - b. Off-register
  - c. Two-tones/multicoloured
- 7. Hand in your best copy of each......3 total
